# THE GREAT COMMISSION

#### Mark 16:15

He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."

Make your faith visible to others. Be joyful in your faith and others will see it.

Always: Pray • Express your faith daily with joy • Be confident • Be loving

Never: Judge • Criticize • Be right for the sake of being right • Tell someone they are wrong!

If you speak the truth and you truly believe, they will see it in you and they will believe. But if you speak the truth and you do not believe, they will see it in you and turn away.

Get comfortable and confident with your Catholic faith. Don't be embarrassed by it. Be joyful and ready to bring it up in public.

Know your witness statement. Be ready to proclaim it always whenever you are asked.

You will never convert anyone. That is the job of the Holy Spirit. But we must plant seeds and nurture them love and care so that the Spirit can reap the harvest.

When speaking about our Catholic faith there are a few things to keep in mind to help bolster your confidence:

Once you get into a dialog about doctrine and beliefs and you've been asked a question you don't know the answer to NEVER be afraid to say, "I don't know." But ALWAYS follow that up with "but I'll find out and get back to you." Then make sure you do!

## WHY APOLOGETICS?

Apologetics is giving a reasoned defense of a position. Catholic Apologetics is giving a reasoned explanation, or defense of Catholic Teaching.

Assumptions for evangelization and apologetics;

- 1. We believe in one God, the creator of the universe and of all things in it.
- 2. We believe in His Son Jesus Christ who died for our sins in order that we might be saved. (Insert Nicene Creed here)
- 3. We believe in the entire body of works we call the Bible, and we believe in all of the teaching and authority of the Church.

Apologetics' from the Greek  $\pi o \lambda o \gamma i \alpha$ , (apologia) is the practice of mounting a reasoned defense of a person, or issue. Here we will provide a reasoned defense of the Catholic Church, based on the scripture that the church herself compiled at its beginning.

#### 1 Peter 3:15-16

<sup>15</sup> But sanctify the Lord Christ in your hearts, being ready always to satisfy every one who asks you a reason of that hope which is in you. <sup>16</sup> But with modesty and fear, having a good conscience: that whereas they speak evil of you, they may be ashamed who falsely accuse your good conversation in Christ.

#### 1 Timothy 3:15

<sup>15</sup> But if I stay long, that thou may know how thou ought to behave in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth.

#### 2 Timothy 4:1-5

<sup>1</sup> I charge you, before God and Jesus Christ, who shall judge the living and the dead, by his coming, and his kingdom: <sup>2</sup> Preach the word: be persistent in convenience or inconvenience: reprove, entreat, rebuke in all patience and doctrine. <sup>3</sup> For there shall be a time, when they will not endure sound doctrine; but, according to their own desires, they will heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears <sup>4</sup> And will indeed turn away their hearing from the truth, and will be turned unto fables. <sup>5</sup> But be vigilant, labour in all things, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry in soberness.

Paul predicted accurately that divisions in the Church would someday occur and commands us to be ever ready to teach and encourage with patience, gentleness and reverence. This is the basics of Apologetics. Teach and encourage with patience gentleness and reverence.

# THE CATHOLIC NABRE

<sup>1</sup> And God spoke all these words, saying,

 $^{\rm 2}$  I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery.

<sup>3</sup> You shall not have other gods beside me.

<sup>4</sup> You shall not make for yourself an idol or a likeness of anything in the heavens above or on the earth below or in the waters beneath the earth;

<sup>5</sup> you shall not bow down before them or serve them. For I, the LORD, your God, am a jealous God, inflicting punishment for their ancestors' wickedness on the children of those who hate me, down to the third and fourth generation;

<sup>6</sup> but showing love down to the thousandth generation of those who love me and keep my commandments.

<sup>7</sup> You shall not invoke the name of the LORD, your God, in vain. For the LORD will not leave unpunished anyone who invokes his name in vain.

<sup>8</sup> Remember the sabbath day-keep it holy.

<sup>9</sup> Six days you may labor and do all your work,
